Coding Decoding Problems Tips and Tricks

- Can be difficult
- Relatively easy to learn, hard to master
- Important topic for examinations
- Three kinds –
 - Type 1 – Jumbled Letters
 - Type 2 – Preceding/Succeeding Letters in Words
 - Type 3 – Alphanumeric Coding

Coding Decoding Problems Tips and Tricks

- **Type 1** – Jumbled alphabets
 - Easy to Hard difficulty
 - No specific pattern for jumbling
 - Somewhat time consuming
 - If in a certain code, MJLNOURAIS is for JOURNALISM, what is for YACNARH?
 - **A – N – A – R – C – H – Y**
 - If in a certain code, OENUCCSQEEN is for CONSEQUENCE, what is for DYCIASECRPN?
 - **D – I – S – C – R – E – P – A – N – C – Y**

Coding Decoding Problems Tips and Tricks

- **Type 2** – Preceding/Succeeding Letters in Words
 - Moderately difficult
 - Either forward (succeeding) or backward (preceding) patterns (mostly)
 - Moderately time consuming
 - If in a certain code, 'INDIA' is written as 'JOEJB', then what would be the word 'INSTITUTION' be?
 - GHDLQSHJITO
 - DJRIDGHHITO
 - FDGUIFDUIDO
 - **JOTUJUVUJPO**

Coding Decoding Problems Tips and Tricks

- **Type 3** – Alphanumeric Coding
 - Moderate – Hard difficulty
 - Includes a combination of both alphabets and numbers
 - Can be time consuming
 - If in a certain code, RHYOLITE is represented as “S8Z15M9U5”, what would “N1H13B” stand for?
 - MUSIC
 - **MAGMA**
 - MAGIC
 - MOMENT



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
