Minimum Educational Qualifications

You must possess the required qualification by the application closing date (08.09.2025).

- **Nursing Superintendent**
B.Sc Nursing OR 3-year course in General Nursing and Midwifery; must be a Registered Nurse and Midwife.
- **Pharmacist (Entry Grade)**
10+2 in Science with Diploma in Pharmacy OR Bachelor degree in Pharmacy (B.Pharma); must be registered under Pharmacy Act, 1948.
- **Health & Malaria Inspector Gr II**
B.Sc. with Chemistry as a subject, plus a 1-year Diploma/NTC in Health/Sanitary Inspector.

Candidates awaiting final results are NOT eligible to apply.

Use the official RRB website link. A valid mobile number and email are mandatory. Details entered here cannot be modified later.

Fill Application Form

Choose only ONE RRB. **Fill all details carefully.** You can indicate your preference for Railway Zones and posts within the chosen RRB.

Capture Live Photo

The application will capture a live photo via webcam/mobile camera.

Key Instructions: Wear dark, non-white clothing. No cap, mask, or glasses. Face must be centered and clearly visible.



4

Upload Signature

Scan and upload your signature.

Specifications: Black ink on white paper, running handwriting (not block letters), JPG/JPEG format, size between 30 KB and 49 KB.



5

Pay Examination Fee

Complete the application by paying the fee online.

Important Note: Multiple applications to different RRBs or the same RRB will lead to the rejection of ALL applications and debarment from future exams.

Application Fee & Refund Policy

General Category

For: All candidates (except categories mentioned below).

₹ 400/- will be refunded to your bank account after you appear for the Computer Based Test (CBT).

Concessional Category

For: SC, ST, Ex-Servicemen, PwBD, Female, Transgender, Minorities, or Economically Backward Class (EBC).

Critical Information

- Payment must be made ONLINE only (Internet Banking, Debit/Credit Card, UPI).

The Selection Journey: From Exam to Empanelment



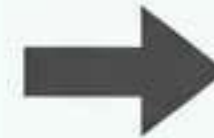
Stage 1: Single Stage Computer Based Test (CBT)

- Objective multiple-choice test.
- Shortlisting of candidates is based purely on merit in the CBT.



Stage 2: Document Verification (DV)

- Candidates equal to the number of vacancies (1:1 ratio) will be called based on CBT merit.
- Verification of all original eligibility, category, and educational certificates.



Stage 3: Medical Examination

- Candidates must pass the requisite medical fitness test for their chosen post(s) conducted by the Railway Administration.

Key Takeaway: Selection is a merit-based, multi-stage process. Each stage is a mandatory qualifying step.

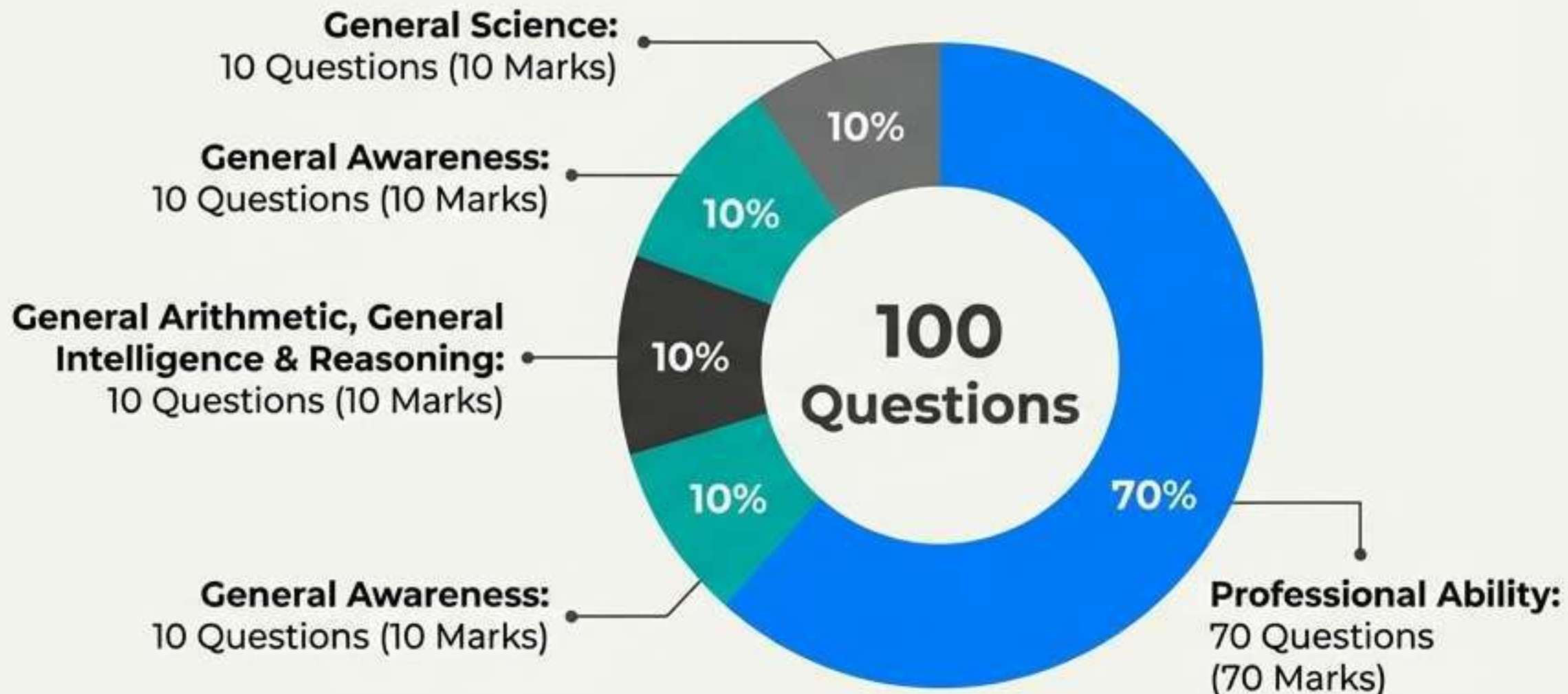

Common Subjects (30 Marks)



- **General Awareness:** Current Affairs, Indian Geography, Culture and History, Indian Polity and Constitution, Economy, Environmental Issues, Sports, etc.



- **General Arithmetic, GI & Reasoning:** Number Systems, BODMAS, Ratio & Proportion, Percentages, Time & Work, Analogies, Series, Coding-Decoding, Syllogism, etc.



- **General Science:** Physics, Chemistry, and Life Sciences (up to 10th Standard CBSE syllabus).

Professional Ability (70 Marks)

Syllabus varies by post. Key examples include:

For Health & Malaria Inspector: Food & Nutrition, Environmental Sanitation, Communicable & Non-Communicable Diseases, Health Statistics.
