Are You Eligible? Core Requirements & Age Relaxations

Core Requirements



Nationality

Must be a citizen of India. Candidates must submit a Domicile/PRC for their state/UT.

Educational Qualification

Must have passed Class 10 / Matriculation from a recognized board or university.

Age Limit

Must be between **18 to 23 years.**


Note: The specific date range for birth will be announced in the official notification. For the previous cycle, it was between 2nd Jan 2003 and 1st Jan 2008.

Age Relaxation

The upper age limit is relaxed for candidates from reserved categories.

Category	Age Relaxation	Effective Upper Age
OBC	3 years	26 years
SC/ST	5 years	28 years
Ex-Servicemen (General)	3 years	26 years
Victims of 1984/2002 Riots (General)	5 years	28 years
