Assistant Central Intelligence Officer (ACIO)

The flagship officer-level role for graduates, focused on intelligence gathering and analysis.




Security Assistant / Executive

An essential entry-level role handling administrative and field support.



Multi-Tasking Staff (MTS)

The foundational support role crucial for office and clerical operations.



Junior Intelligence Officer (JIO) - Technical

A specialized path for candidates with technical diplomas or engineering degrees.

A Closer Look: Responsibilities & Qualifications

Post	Group	Core Responsibilities	Educational Requirement
Assistant Central Intelligence Officer (ACIO)	B	Intelligence gathering, analysis, surveillance, reporting, assisting seniors	Graduate in any discipline
Security Assistant / Executive	C	Administrative tasks, record-keeping, assisting field ops, regional intel collection	10th or 12th pass with local language knowledge
Multi-Tasking Staff (MTS)	C	Office support, document handling, clerical work, assisting field staff	10th pass
Junior Intelligence Officer (JIO) / Technical	B	Cybersecurity ops, technical surveillance, data analysis, tech intel support	Diploma or degree in engineering/technical field

The Starting Line: Are You Eligible to Apply?

Key Requirement: All candidates must be Indian citizens. Age relaxation is provided for SC/ST/OBC/Ex-servicemen as per government rules.

Your Journey to a Career in the IB: The Selection Process



Online Application

Applications are submitted exclusively online via the MHA or NCS portals. No offline forms are accepted.



Written Examination

Tier I (Objective) tests General Awareness, Quant, Reasoning, and English. Tier II may be descriptive or skill-based.



Interview / Skill Test

Shortlisted candidates from the written exam face an interview (for ACIO/JIO) or a skill-based assessment.



Document Verification

Final stage to verify all educational, identity, and other required credentials before selection.


Who Can Apply?

Essential Skills


- Analytical thinking

When to Apply



Recruitment is conducted periodically based on vacancies. Check the official websites regularly for the latest notifications for ACIO, SA, and MTS posts.

Answering Your Key Questions

Can I join the IB right after 10th grade?

Yes, you can apply for the Multi-Tasking Staff (MTS) or Security Assistant (SA) positions if you meet the age and language criteria.

Is graduation compulsory for all IB posts?

No. Graduation is mandatory only for higher-level posts like ACIO. MTS and SA have 10th/12th pass requirements.

How competitive is the ACIO exam?

It is moderately to highly competitive due to the large number of applicants and limited vacancies. Thorough preparation is key to success.

Can foreign nationals apply for IB jobs?

No. All positions in the Intelligence Bureau are reserved for Indian citizens only.
